Summer Camp Handbook

Dear Parents,

Welcome to summer camp at SILCAG! Your child is enrolled in one or more weeks of our Summer Camp at our school. We have 8 very excited weeks of summer camp in June and July planned! Please read this handbook carefully as it has some very important information about our camps.

Important Information:

1. **Hours:** Summer Camp is from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM. Please be on time to drop off and pick-up. Please do not arrive before 9:00 AM and please pick-up no later than 1:10 PM. **IMPORTANT:** Parents, you must pick your child up on time! We want to let you know that SILCAG is giving you a 10 minute tolerance. Please, be informed that **AFTER TEN MINUTES**, SILCAG will charge \$5.00 per minute. No exceptions. Thank you so much for your understanding.
2. **Parents has the opportunity to inform in advance to SILCAG that your child is going to be after 1:00 PM** for our Summer Camp After School Program. It will be \$10.00 per hour. Please let us know in advance if you are interested.
Please know, you must come in the building for drop off and pick up for you to sign your child in and out each time. For the safety of our children, the procedure for pick-up is to give them one by one at the lobby after you signed them out on the sheet. (We don't want any children running around in the school unattended). This might take some time, and therefore, we ask for your patience.
3. **Food:** Please send a snack in a separate bag labeled with your child's name and "snack". This will help us know what you would like your child to eat for snack and what for lunch. Please pack a lunch with a drink with your child each day except for the "cooking day" (Wednesday's do not send lunch) where kids will be cooking their own lunch.
Not peanuts or Nuts allowed! Please make sure all items are labeled with your child's name.
4. **Clothes:** Please dress your child in play clothes and play shoes that are comfortable for all kinds of movements.
5. **Shoes:** Please have your child wear play shoes (sneakers with socks are best, No Flip Flops, Sandals, or Crocs).
6. **Allergies:** If your child has any allergies especially food, please make sure you talk to your child's teacher first thing Monday morning. **If your child has an epi-pen, you Must talk to your child's teacher.**

7. **Name Labels:** Anything you can put your child's name on (lunch, snack, coat, bag, etc.) Please do visibly. We will have many kids every day so we will not know what belongs to each child.
